# 2023 Morrow County 4-H Camp Information Come Join Us for Camp Fun! Ahoy mate it's a Pirate Adventure!! July 9th – July 13<sup>th</sup>



#### Who can sign up for camp......

Youth ages 8 years old <u>and</u> in 3<sup>rd</sup> grade (as of Jan. 1) or 9 (as of Jan. 1) and any grade up to youth who are in 8<sup>th</sup> grade (as of Jan. 1, 2023) are invited to attend the Morrow County 4-H Camp held at 4-H Camp Ohio.

## When is camp?

4-H Camp will begin on July 9<sup>th</sup> late afternoon (times will be scheduled for drop off) with registration and will end/pickup on the morning of July 13 (times will be scheduled for pick up). Campers must provide their own transportation and for the health and safety of campers will not be permitted to leave and return to camp.

### Where is 4-H Camp Ohio?

4-H Camp Ohio is located in St. Louisville, Ohio, 8 miles northeast of Utica and approximately 40 miles southeast of Mt. Gilead. Campers live in one of 18 cabins, with 10-15 campers, and at least two trained counselors. A modern kitchen and central dining hall provide nutritious meals. Facilities on camp include the Olympic size Swimming Pool, Nature Center, Craft Hall, Camp Store, Log Cabin, Campfire Circle, Vespers Hill Site, Team Challenge Course, Zipping and Climbing Tower, Archery Range, and Sports Field. ### **Health and Safety**

Assuring the health and safety of each camper is important to us at camp! We will require a complete health form and <u>picture</u> from every camper. Campers are covered by a supplemental health and safety policy while involved in camp programs. Activities are supervised by trained counselors and adult staff. Physical or health problems should be shared with the camp health staff who are on duty 24 hours per day. Serious injuries or illness will be handled through the Licking Memorial Hospital or Knox Community Hospital and parents will be contacted immediately. **Also, for our youth safety NO electronic communication devices/cell phones** are allowed by campers and counselors during camp.

#### What do campers do at camp?

You'll have fun meeting other kids from Morrow County while participating in a variety of camp sessions/activities like crafts, archery, nature sessions, stream study, Native American living, pioneer living, swimming, canoeing, singing, hiking, team challenge, high ropes, zipping, climbing wall, and more. During other times all youth will get the chance to experience cooking over a campfire, going to camp fire programs, flag programs, fun all camp evening recreation, fun skits, sports and games of all kinds, learning independent living, making decisions and much more!

# Registration And Health Form Due. . . .

There are 220 camper spots available for youth this year! All ON LINE Registrations are due June 16<sup>st</sup> and Heath form is due June 21<sup>st</sup> (4-H Project Member priority deadline) If room is available After June 21<sup>st</sup> non-4-H project members may register, the price will increase to \$200 (contact the Extension Office). Registration is open on a first-come first-served basis. The cost for 4-H Camp is \$110 for Morrow County 4-H Project Members enrolled as of April 30<sup>th</sup>. At camp children will get nutritious meals, 4 overnight accommodations, evening snacks and drinks, a camp photo, trained experienced staff, counselors with at least 12 + hours of training, 2 health staff on duty 24/7 and lots and lots of fun camping activities (see listing of a few above)!!

If you are interested in the Weiler Family Camp Discount Scholarship you will get an option on the registration form to fill out a separate form due June 16<sup>th</sup>. Once received and notified if receiving a scholarship all balances and health form will be due June 21<sup>st</sup>.
