Opportunity	Age/Grade Requirements on January 1 <sup>st</sup> , 2023	Description	Costs/Donors
<b>Morrow County Junior Fair Board</b>	15 years <u>or</u> a freshman in high school or older	<u>Ten</u> 4-H members will be chosen to represent the 4-H program on the Junior Fair board. Member's chosen will take part in making decisions, planning, and working the fair. Members are <u>required</u> to attend monthly meetings (1 <sup>st</sup> Monday of month), attend workdays, and the fair.	
<b>Morrow County 4-H Advisory Committee</b>	15 years <u>or</u> older <u>or</u> a freshman in high school	Among adult advisors serving on the 4-H Advisory Board – 4-H teens will join them in advising 4-H Educators county programing needs as well as work on countywide events.

<b>Morrow County 4-H HealthU Ambassador</b>	Must be in grades 9-12	Teens promote healthy living, from nutrition, physical wellness, to emotional wellness etc.	
<b>Morrow County STEM Ambassador</b>	14 years or older	Do you have a passion for STEM? Amanda's looking for teens to help decide what STEM activities youth of our county want to learn more about. You'd help plan and execute activities, workshops, and field trips that would be county-wide and maybe even state and national programs. A few examples include planning the science activities for 4-H camp, a field trip like the one to Stone Lab, and create summer workshops for youth. You do not have to be an expert in STEM, just the desire to help the STEM program.	
<b>Morrow County Food &amp; Fashion Board</b>	13 years <u>or</u> older <u>or</u> at least in the 7 <sup>th</sup> grade	Food & Fashion Board gives leadership to Morrow County projects and activities related to food and clothing. Past activities include a fun and educational trip, making quilts, canoeing, style show, and judging.	
<b>Morrow County 4-H Camp Counselor</b> July 9-13, 2023 Where: 4-H Camp Ohio	A freshman in high school <u>or</u> older	This year, we will be selecting several boys and girls to be counselors for the Morrow County 4-H Camp. Counselors are <u>required</u> to attend 20-hours of training meetings, will be given a large amount of responsibility with youth ages 8-14, and attend Counselors Camp in April as a 1 <sup>st</sup> year counselor.	

<b>State 4-H Teen Leadership Council</b>	Age 14 to 18 years old	TLC is a statewide group of 4-H teens that provide a teen perspective in the planning, implementation, and evaluation of Ohio 4-H programming.	
<b>State 4-H Achievement Awards &amp; Scholarship</b>	14 years <u>or</u> older and at least 4 years of project work in one area.	Members must show involvement in the county and state 4-H program activities, as well as increased knowledge and work in their 4-H project(s). Interested members should check the appropriate box on the application.	
<b>Ohio Military Kids Camp Counselor</b> August	16 years or older	Teen leaders needed for camps and other events with an interest. This program supports children and families of National Guard, Reserve, and Active-Duty Service.	
<b>State Citizenship Washington Focus</b> Middle of June	Current Freshman in High School and older	4-H'ers learn essential civic leadership skills and leave with the tools that will allow them to bring about real change in their communities	Cost to Member: Free Donor: Advisory Comm
<b>State Buckeye Leadership Workshop</b> March Recreation Unlimited	15 years <u>or</u> older <u>or</u> a freshman in high school	Buckeye Leadership Workshop held annually at Recreation Unlimited, provides sessions that strengthen participants' leadership skills within a recreation setting. <b>State Sea Camp</b> July Where: Kelleys Island	Teen's age 15 to 17 (as of the first day of camp)	The mission of Ohio 4-H Sea Camp is to offer teenage youth an introduction to the Great Lakes through hands-on experiences in a variety of aquatic-based programs. Sea Camp will enable participants to experience Lake Erie-based activities and culture such as aquatic science, water recreation, and fishing.	Cost to Member: \$100 Donor: Advisory Committee
<b>State Leadership Camp</b> June 1-5, 2023 Where: 4-H Camp Ohio	15 years <u>or</u> older & have completed at least one year of 4-H	4-H State Leadership Camp is a premier leadership development opportunity that offers participants engaging sessions in topics such as motivation, courage, teamwork, and more!
