Goat, Rabbit and Poultry Industry Ambassador Rules

1. Contestant can be male or female and must be single and between the ages of 8 and in the 3rd grade and 18 as of January 1.
2. A Junior Ambassador age 8 – 13 and a Senior Ambassador age 14–18 will be selected for each species as of Jan. 1st.
3. The contestant must have a current project in their select project area (goat/poultry/rabbit) through Morrow County 4-H or FFA. Contestant can only select one specie to represent/apply for in current year.
4. Contestants will be judged on the basis of personality (20%); ability to express her/himself, both in writing and verbally (30%); 4-H, FFA, FHA, and other activities (10%) and knowledge of the overall industry they are representing (40%).
5. Contestants must reside in Morrow County or belong to a Morrow County Youth Organization.
6. The Morrow County 4-H Goat, Rabbit and Poultry Committees or representatives appointed by them will act as judges. Senior Ambassador can be part of the interview committee for the following year.
7. Ambassadors will participate in the Morrow County Fair, County Clinics, and other promotional activities.
8. Eligible members can be selected as a Junior or Senior Ambassador for multiple years in each age division with one year between each award. Except when Junior to Senior age division takes place, an individual may win Junior Ambassador as a 13-year-old and the next year apply and win Senior Ambassador as a 14 year old.
