Trash Bash 2025 Important Dates

Registration Opens January 30

February 18 - May 28 : Clean-up Supply Request*

*Required: minimum of one week ahead of clean-up date

March 3- June 5 : Teams clean up litter along Morrow County roads

June 9 : Last Day to dispose of trash with Mid-Ohio Sanitation & Recycling



4-H clubs that complete a litter cleanup between March 3 and June 5...

...are Eligible for a free Movie Night Raffle at Capitol Theater in Mt. Gilead if all forms are completed, signed and turned into the office no later than 2 weeks after their Trash Bash cleanup date or June 9 (whichever comes first). In addition, clean supplies, supplies in working order, and unused supplies must be returned to the office, and litter must be properly disposed. Photo documentation may be required to validate and verify the completion of a Trash Bash cleanup.

- 3) Signup for Litter Pickup and Safety Supplies, if needed (offered until supplies are exhausted)
- 4) Download the Recycling and Trash Collection Form
Must complete this form for enrolling in program and receiving future supplies
- 5) Dispose of your collected litter responsibly!
