Busy, Busy, Busy! As I write this, people are in and out of the office, noises though out the fair grounds and fair hasn't even started yet! This will go to print when your household will be in full swing for fair and then it will be here and gone. People ask if I'm glad when fair ends - the quiet is deafening for the rest of the week. I would like to thank ALL those who help make fair possible. It is definitely NOT a one man/woman show!! Reminders to think about:

ALL Market projects that go through the sale ring will need to turn a Thank You in for the buyer. It is recommended that they be turned in by the end of September. You have to turn them in before your sale check is released. Sale checks are usually ready to release at the end of the first Full week of October. This allows the buyers checks to be processed before the exhibitor's checks are released. Thank you notes should be turned in at the Junior Fair Office or the Extension Office. If no one is at the fair office you may put them in the secure black mail box outside the Youth Building. It is located to the right of the door that has Youth Building above it. The envelope should be addressed to the buyer and under the exhibitor's name they should list the specie they sold. Example is shown below.

Fair checks need to be cashed within 90 days of them being written. If you go past this date exhibitor will have to have check reissued which incurs a fee. If you choose to put the uncashed check in a 6 month CD at Farmers Citizen Bank in Cardington the exhibitor and their organization will receive a bonus from the bank. A program worth checking into!

Premiums will be released in October also. These may be picked up by club advisor or exhibitor or exhibitor's representative. Check with your club to see what the policy is for your club. We wish you all a good fair and fall!!
