- 12. Hunter/English Seat Equitation on Flat (14-18)
- 13. Hunter/English Seat Equitation on Flat (8-13)
- 14. Walk Trot Hunter/English Seat Equitation on Flat (8-18) **See Walk Trot Rules**
- 15. Hunter/English Seat Pleasure (14-18) Hunt or Saddle Seat
- 16. Hunter/English Seat Pleasure (8-13) Hunt or Saddle Seat
- 17. Walk Trot Hunter/English Seat Pleasure (8-18) **See Walk Trot Rules**
- 18. Hunter/English Seat Pairs Class (8-18) Walk, trot, canter in groups of two. NO POINTS Double-entry fee and payback
- Novice Hunter/English Seat Equitation (8-18) Exhibitor must have shown but could not have placed in any riding class on this day.
 Walk Trot exhibitors not eligible to show in this class. <u>NO POINTS</u>
 - ***OVER FENCES CLASSES RULES (For Classes 20 35) Each horse/rider combination may enter in Only one (1) division: Ground Poles OR Cross-rails OR 2 ft.
- 20. Warm Up Ground Poles (not judged, warm up class for all ground pole classes) NO POINTS No entry fee
- 21. Walk Trot Equitation Over Ground Poles (8-18) **See Walk Trot Rules**
- 22. Jr Ground Pole Equitation (8-13) *** Ground poles are shown at a walk trot. Open to riders/horses of any age who have never shown over fences of cross rails or higher
- 23. Sr Ground Pole Equitation (14-18) *** Rules same as previous class
- 24. Jr Hunter Over Fences- ground poles (8-13) *** Rules same as previous class
- 25. Sr Hunter Over Fences- ground poles (14-18) *** Rules same as previous class
- 26. Cross-Rails Warm Up (not judged, warm up for all cross-rail classes) *** NO POINTS No entry fee
- 27. Jr Equitation Over Fences- cross rails (8-13)***Open to horses/riders who have never shown at a canter over a course of fences 18" or higher
- 28. Sr Equitation Over Fences cross rails (14-18)*** Rules same as previous class
- 29. Jr Working Hunter Over Fences cross rails (8-13)*** Rules same as previous class
- 30. Sr Working Hunter Over Fences cross rails (14-18)*** Rules same as previous class
- 31. Two Foot Warm Up (not judged, warm up for all 2-foot classes) NO POINTS No entry fee
- 32. **Jr Equitation Over Fences 2 Foot (8-13)***** Open to horse/rider combination that have previously had experience showing 18" or above.
- 33. Sr Equitation Over Fences 2 Foot (14-18)*** Rules same as previous class
- 34. Jr Working Hunter Over Fences- 2 foot (8-13)*** Rules same as previous class
- 35. Sr Working Hunter Over Fences- 2 foot (14-18)***Rules same as previous class
- 36. <u>PRACTICE</u> Hunter Hack Warm-Up (Height 18") <u>Exhibitor allowed ONE RUN THROUGH PER ENTRY.</u> <u>No entry fee or placings NO POINTS</u>

^{**}WALK TROT RULES: An exhibitor who enters the Walk-Trot class must be a first- or second-year horse member or experienced rider with a novice horse. If a horse is injured and cannot lope, a member may enter in the Walk-Trot class if they provide a veterinarian's note. Certain exceptions may be approved by the 4-H Horse & Pony Committee. Not eligible to show in any Novice classes during the fair. Tie Breaker for Walk Trot will be Highest Placing in: 1. Showmanship 2. Barrels
