Raising an animal as a livestock project is a valuable experience for any Junior Fair exhibitor. Livestock projects teach our youth responsibility, caring, fairness, respect and trustworthiness.

Because our youth are raising these animals on a small scale, costs are higher and it is hard to break even at market price. As a supporter of the Junior Fair Livestock Sale, you have the opportunity to help these exhibitors by attending the sale, bidding and purchasing their livestock projects.

The Junior Fair Livestock Sale gives these young people a chance to show a profit for their hard work. The success of the sale and the support of our youth are up to all of us.

The gross total for the 2021 Junior Fair Livestock Sale was \$523,153.06. THIS IS A NEW RECORD!

## HOW TO MAKE A PURCHASE

**Existing Buyers** – No need to check in. Just use the Buyer Number that was mailed to you prior to the sale to make your purchases. Buyer's names will be announced as listed on your Buyer Number. If you have any changes, please stop in to the clerks table prior to the Sale.

**New Buyers** – Welcome! Register as early as 8:30 am at the clerks table near the front of the Show Arena to receive your Buyer Number.

**Add-Ons and Bumps** – Buyers may choose to contribute to the Sale by "Adding On" to a specific seller. Buyers may also choose to "Bump" an entire species, group of sellers, etc to a minimum dollar amount or spread a lump sum of money over a group of sellers. *All Add-Ons and Bumps must be done at the clerks table* – none will be accepted at the auction stand during the Sale. *Only bumps of entire species will be announced.*

## HOW TO BID

All animals are sold by Premium Bid. Base bids are made by processors prior to the Sale based on market price. The Base Bid for each animal is listed in the Sale Program.

The Premium Bid is what you bid during the Sale. This is over and above the Base Bid. All sellers receive the total of the Base and Premium Bids, regardless of where the animal cuts up.

Be prepared to tell the ringmen what you want done with your animal after your winning bid.

## HOW TO USE YOUR PURCHASE

ALL Poultry and Rabbits must go "On the truck. ONLY Dairy and Beef Feeders may go "Back to the Barn."

1. Resell the animal to the Base Bidder by telling the ringmen "On the Truck".  
Animal – Responsibility of the Base Bidder  
Buyer Pays – Premium Bid only
2. Send the animal for processing by telling the ringmen the "Name of the Processor".  
Animal – It is your responsibility to make arrangements with the processor.  
Buyer Pays – Base Bid + Premium Bid
3. Dairy and Beef Feeders ONLY Take the animal home by telling the ringmen "Back to the Barn".  
Animal – Your responsibility to get the animal home.  
Buyer Pays – Base Bid + Premium Bid

Grand and Reserve Champion Large Animals must be slaughtered by Link's Country Meats.

Buyers will receive a photo plaque and listing in a local newspaper. You are also invited to enjoy a complimentary lunch provided by the Morrow County Commodity groups and several local individuals and businesses.

## PROCESSING YOUR PURCHASE

There are several meat-processing plants in the area that will process your animal(s) for your freezer or for your business. Buyers need to make arrangements with the processor preferably before the sale.

## HOW MUCH MEAT CAN YOU GET

From a purchase you can receive approximately the following amount of meat. Many factors affect the amount of the various meat cuts obtained from a carcass.

- 1,100 pound Beef      110 pound Lamb
- Approximately 450 lbs.      Approximately 45 lbs. of various cuts of meat.
- 250 pound Hog      of various cuts of meat.
- Approximately 180 lbs. of various cuts of meat.

## TERMS OF THE SALE

Payment must be made the day of the Sale at the Clerks Table. The Clerks Table will close approximately 1 hour after the end of the Large Animal Sale. Any other payment arrangements must be made with the Sale Committee Treasurer prior to leaving the Sale. Cash, Check and all major credit cards are accepted. A 4% convenience fee will be added to all credit card transactions. A \$35 fee will be charged for all returned checks.
